#### **Outreach Initiatives**

### **Participation in Job Fairs**

Unlock Your Future (Oct. 2, 2024) –Large career event, which drew 1,500 middle school students from 24 schools over three sessions. We presented the CENW website to at least 400 students.

Launch NW Senior Summit (October 15, 2024) – Tabled and presented CENW to approximately 200 seniors.

Whitman County High School Career Fair (November 19, 2024) – Breakout sessions shared CENW and CENW Live with 30 high schoolers from six rural high schools.

Fairchild AFB Meet the Employer (November 22, 2024) – Shared the CENW website with 20 transitioning airmen as a resource for identifying and connecting with area employers (if they are staying in eastern Washington) or for their children to generally start exploring career options.

Spokane Public Schools 10<sup>th</sup> Grade Career Launch (December 10, 2024) – Tabled at this annual event for 10<sup>th</sup> grade students from all Spokane public schools as well as several other area school districts. They shared the CENW website with approximately 300 high school students and 20 teachers.

Spokane Valley Tech STEM Night (January 22, 2025) – Tabled at this first-time event for families which featured hands-on activities that focus on getting students excited to learn STEM. Topics included Robotics, Computer Science, Engineering, Cyber Security, Manufacturing, and Environmental Science. Jason shared CENW with about 50 participants.

Fairchild AFB Meet the Employer (January 31, April 11, 2025) – Tabled at this monthly career event for transitioning airmen and shared CENW with approximately 60 Transition Assistance Program (TAP) students between the two events.

Spokane Ag Show (February 5-6, 2025) – The Spokane Ag Show, the largest farm show in the Inland Northwest, is both an exhibition and an educational event. It attracts over 5,700 attendees. Feb 5, connected with several potential CENW spotlight sponsor organizations, as well as one group that will help source a Crop/Soils Science presenter for CENW Live. On February 6, tabled at the career fair and presented CENW to approximately 30 students.

girlConNW (February 8, 2025) – Tabled at this annual event and presented CENW to 40 Girl Scouts.

Spokane Public Schools 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Career Fair (April 1, 2025) – Tabled for CENW, KSPS team conducted a mock weather forecasting activity for kids. 800 5<sup>th</sup> graders, parents, and teachers.

Future Ready Trades Night (East Valley, Central Valley, West Valley, and Freeman High Schools - April 2, 2025) – Presented the CENW website to approximately 120 high school students, parents and teachers.

Deer Park High School Career Fair (April 23, 2025) Tabled for CENW at this fair and shared the program with 30 students.

Riverside Middle School Career Fair (April 24, 2025) Tabled at this event and presented CENW to 100 students ranging Grades 3-12, plus three adults.

Cusick High School Career Fair (April 24, 2025) – Tabled at this fair for Cusick, Northport and Selkirk high schools. Presented CENW to 80 students, which included some Cusick middle and grade school students who visited the fair.

The best part was the opportunity for so many – including parents and teachers – to see a variety of career options and opportunities available.
